Court Finds Measure J Constitutional

In case you missed it, an appellate court has ruled that Measure J, a monumental Los Angeles County criminal justice reform initiative that was approved by voters in 2020, is constitutional. This decision, which comes from a three-judge panel of California's 2nd District Court of Appeal, reverses a 2021 decision from an L.A. County Superior Court Judge that struck down Measure J.
