Year Two CFCI Care Grant Applications are now LIVE! Any Community Based Organization (CBO) that works in the below areas, is encouraged to apply:

- Youth Development and Education
- · Assistance with Housing
- Workforce Development and Job Placement
- Violence and Exploitation Prevention
- Re-entry Services

Out of 588 CBOs who applied in Year One, 118 were awarded Care Grants. That's 20% - a very significant chance for all whom apply.
