Housing, employment, legal aid, and more for justice impacted individuals, particularly those on adult felony supervision

# POWR (Providing Opportunities for Women in Reentry)

Serving system involved women who are 18 + with peer-led mentorship, interim housing, care coordination and more

# YO! (Youth Overcoming)

Transformative mentorship curriculum for transitional age youth age 18-26 incl. group support sessions, transportation to and from court appointments, case management and more

### **Reentry Interim Housing**

Providing interim housing to prevent and reduce homelessness and reduce recidivism

#### **College and Careers**

Providing voluntary supportive services for individuals on adult felony probation
