18-27

and all participants must meet the physical requirements of the program.



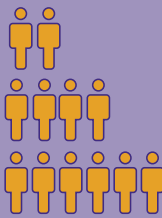
GOAL

The program will primarily prepare transition-aged youth with prior justice and/or foster system involvement for careers in the fire service, increase employment opportunities among typically disadvantaged populations, and help reduce recidivism.



SIZE

20 Participants

60 Participants



PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE:

- housing and supportive services
- on the job training
- record expungement services (as needed)
- life skills training
- career guidance

TARGET OUTCOMES



Provide all participants with access to necessary services and programming.



Provide all participants with training, certifications, mentorship necessary to prepare for careers in the fire services.



Link all participants with living wage jobs in their fields of interest to access employment by or upon completion of the program.

ROADMAP

FACILITY

ISD completed phase I renovations at Camp Gonzales in January 2023. This will allow JCOD to enroll 20 participants in the LACTC. ISD is in the phase II, which upon completion will allow JCOD to enroll up to 60 participants.

PROVIDERS

JCOD will use a community-based training provider and program administrator. JCOD is partnering with LA County Fire Department to provide additional trainings.
