

#### **TARGET OUTCOMES**



Provide all participants with access to necessary services and programming.

#### GOAL

The program will primarily prepare transitionaged youth with prior justice and/or foster system involvement for careers in the fire service, increase employment opportunities among typically disadvantaged populations, and help reduce recidivism.



#### **PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE:**

- housing and supportive services
- on the job training
- record expungement services (as needed)
- life skills training
- career guidance



Provide all participants with training, certifications, mentorship necessary to prepare for careers in the fire services.



Link all participants with living wage jobs in their fields of interest to access employment by or upon completion of the program.

### **ROADMAP**

#### **FACILITY**

ISD completed phase I renovations at Camp Gonzales in January 2023.

This will allow JCOD to enroll 20 participants in the LACTC. ISD is in the phase II, which upon completion will allow JCOD to enroll up to 60 participants.

#### **PROVIDERS**

JCOD will use a community-based training provider and program administrator. JCOD is partnering with LA County Fire Department to provide additional trainings.
