

BACKGROUND



LA County's Justice, Care and Opportunities Department (JCOD) is leading a collaborative effort to design an integrated solution to connect justice impacted individuals to services and resources. Partnering with a vendor and benefiting from strategic consulting and guidance from the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) within the Chief Executive's Office, JCOD is working to consolidate service and provider information into a single platform, known as "LA County CareConnect".

Justice impacted individuals will be able to access services quickly and more effectively. While justice involved individuals are the initial focus, the goal is for these services to be available to all LA County residents.

CareConnect will serve as a central platform, allowing individuals seeking services to search for providers. Staff can create accounts to connect with clients through referrals. This approach aims to bridge existing gaps and deliver coordinated services to clients seeking assistance with needs such as housing, mental and physical health care, and food and clothing.
