Provides one year of training and technical assistance that focuses on organizational growth, management contracting, capacity mapping, and mentorship for community based organizations (CBOs) that serve communities and people who are justice involved.



Focus on CBOs run by underrepresented groups, including those with lived experience



Addresses the supply bottlenecks in housing and treatment that present barriers to improved wellbeing and prevention

PHASE 01



Nonprofit management & growth, L.A. County contracts, best practices in reentry, and communications & grant writing

PHASE 02



Leveraging relationships with established providers & other experts to provide training, technical assistance, and coaching

PHASE 03



Financial management, action plan, and capacity building
