



In November 2022, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors established the Justice, Care and Opportunities Department (JCOD) to streamline services available to justice-impacted individuals while keeping communities safe.

The Justice Care and Opportunities Department, focuses on three main goals:

#### Re-Entry Services

Establishing programs for justice-impacted people, including diverting them out of the justice system at every turn, and assisting them with re-entry into society.

#### Empowerment

Empowering Community Based Organizations who serve vulnerable populations via training, and hundreds of millions of dollars in direct funding to those organizations.

#### Pretrial services

Individuals detained for non-serious, non-violent offenses get connected to services instead of jail time.
