

Providing Opportunities for Women in Reentry

JCOD's POWR (Providing Opportunities for Women in Reentry) Program offers re-entry services to justice-involved women and their children. POWR aims to deliver gender-responsive, culturally attuned trauma-informed services with the goal of preventing recidivism and improving the health and stability of its participants. The POWR Program consists of the following service components:



Peer led mentorship and Case management



Care coordination and service linkage to employment, housing, legal, family reunification, public benefits, mental health and substance use treatment, and obtaining identification documents.



Evidence-based 12-week trauma group facilitated by Community Health Workers (CHW).



Transportation from and to court appointments



Interim Housing
