

Warm Landing Place

OVERVIEW

JCOD's Warm Landing Place (WLP) provides voluntary, trauma-informed support to individuals immediately after their release from the Downtown Los Angeles jails complex, as part of Los Angeles County's Care First approach. WLP staff engage participants at two locations: a resource table within the Inmate Reception Center (IRC) release area and the Warm Landing Place trailer, located between the IRC and the Community Visiting Area. Individuals receive immediate support and care coordination, including food and water, transportation assistance, and connections to housing, behavioral health care, substance use treatment, public benefits, employment services, legal assistance, family reunification, and other essential community resources. Participants who need a safe place to stay may be connected to JCOD's 29-bed interim housing program, where they receive temporary housing, case management, and support to help them transition to permanent housing.

As Los Angeles County's first dedicated reentry hub at the point of release, JCOD's Warm Landing Place creates a bridge from custody to community by providing immediate, coordinated support that improves outcomes for justice-impacted individuals and advances public safety.

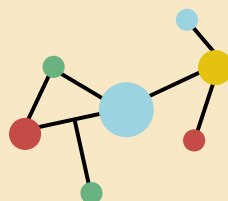
